- transcends reliance on rules, guidelines, and maxims
- "intuitive grasp of situations based on deep, tacit understanding"
- · has "vision of what is possible"
- uses "analytical approaches" in new situations or in case of problems

Definition of an expert

 An expert is someone widely recognized as a reliable source of technique or skill whose faculty for judging or deciding rightly, justly, or wisely is accorded authority and status by their peers or the public in a specific welldistinguished domain.

Definition of an expert

 An expert can be, by virtue of <u>credential</u>, <u>training</u>, <u>education</u>, <u>profession</u>, <u>publication</u> or <u>experience</u>, believed to have special knowledge of a subject beyond that of the average person, sufficient that others may <u>officially</u> (and <u>legally</u>) rely upon the individual's <u>opinion</u>.

Expert colposcopist

- Recognise the finer points of the normal and congenital transformation zone
- Have a high positive predictive value for high grade disease
- Recognise and understand and perform the management for CGIN
- Recognise and understand and perform the management for microinvasion
- Recognise and understand and perform the management for VAIN

Expert colposcopist

- Recognise the features of DES exposure
- Understand, recognise and know how to manage CIN and CGIN and Microinvasion in pregnancy
- Understand, recognise and know how to manage CIN and CGIN and Microinvasion in imuno-compromised women

Expert colposcopist

- Have experience of several local destructive treatments – cryotherapy, radical diathermy, cold coagulation, laser ablation
- Have experience of several excisional methods Lletz, Laser cone, knife cone, Swetz, Netz
- Be experienced with second and third time treatments e.g. with superpulse laser
