André KIND is a specialist in Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University Women's Hospital in Basel, Switzerland, where He leads the Department of Lower Genital Tract Diseases, including the colposcopy unit. Teaching is not only an integral part of his work, but a core commitment. He is jointly responsible for the training of Swiss resident physicians in colposcopy and serve as a member of the joint committee for the training and examination of colposcopists in German-speaking countries.

With a background in public health, his work extends beyond personalized medicine to include a strong focus on healthcare systems. He lived in sub-Saharan Africa for several years and continue to organize regular colposcopy training courses there. Being aware of the considerable disparities both globally and within Europe, he strongly supports the EFC's mission to standardize and harmonize prevention, colposcopic practice, and related fields across Europe and beyond.
