Prof. Mihaela Grigore is Chief of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at “Grigore T. Popa” University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Iași, Romania. She is a dedicated gynecologist-obstetrician with extensive expertise in cervical, vaginal, and vulvar pathology, with a particular focus on colposcopy and cervical cancer prevention.

She currently serves as President of the Romanian Society of Colposcopy and Lower Genital Tract Pathology, and as Vice President of both the Romanian Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology and the Romanian Society of Gynecologic Oncology. Through these roles, she contributes to advancing national strategies in women’s health and strengthening professional collaboration.

Prof. Grigore has a strong and active involvement within the European Federation of Colposcopy (EFC). She is a member of the EFC Quality Assurance Committee and currently serves as interim Treasurer of the Federation, gaining direct experience in its governance, financial structure, and operational coordination. She is also a member of the EFC Board and has been actively involved in the organization of advanced colposcopy courses under the EFC, supporting education and standardization across Europe.

Her academic work includes numerous publications focused on cervical cancer screening and the management of preinvasive disease. She is strongly committed to improving the quality, accessibility, and harmonization of cervical cancer prevention programs.

A promoter of evidence-based medicine, she is the founder and advisory board member of Cochrane Romania, supporting the integration of high-quality evidence into clinical practice.

As a candidate for Secretary-General of the EFC, Prof. Grigore aims to further strengthen internal communication, transparency, and collaboration within the Federation, while supporting education, quality assurance, and the continuous development of colposcopy standards across Europe.
